Museo Ixchel Curator Violeta Gutiérrez organized a special tour of the newly-renovated *Museo Nacional de Arte Maya, Arqueología, y Etnografía*. Some may recall a musty pink building and antiquated galleries. Prepare to be amazed! It is gorgeously redone with multi-lingual labels, the latest technology, and brilliant displays of their many treasures.

We enjoyed our Museo work sessions and meeting the new, talented additions to their Board. Regarding our projects, we were glad to see the field research in Huehuetenango completed and agreed to fund work in the Alta Verapaz. Documenting these challenging remote regions is vital work.
